HENRY KENDALL DRIVE TO  
QUEENS LAKE SAILING CLUB

<b>3.2km</b>	<b>1 hour</b>	<b>Easy</b>

**Difficulty:** Easy. Flat with gravel paths and boardwalks. Some uneven surfaces.

**Amenities:** Public toilets (Henry Kendall Reserve)

### STAGE 2

QUEENS LAKE SAILING CLUB TO SIRIUS DRIVE

<b>1.2km</b>	<b>30min</b>	<b>Moderate</b>
<small>DISTANCE (ONE WAY)</small>	<small>APPROX. TIME</small>	<small>DIFFICULTY</small>

**Difficulty:** Moderate. Gravel paths and boardwalks. Some steeper sections and uneven surfaces. Not suitable for those with mobility issues.



The Queens Lake Walking Trail is a 4.4km walk along the picturesque Queens Lake in Camden Haven. The trail will take you through eucalypt groves, tidal mangrove flats and paperbark forests with stunning views across Queens Lake at every point.

With a wide variety of bird species, lizards and even koalas, this walk promises to be a nature lover's dream.

Henry Kendall Reserve is a great place to start this walk with ample shaded parking, toilets, picnic tables and beautiful views of Stingray Creek.

From Henry Kendall Reserve you will need to walk back along Henry Kendall Drive towards Ocean Drive. Half way along Henry Kendall Drive on the right hand side you will find the Queens Lake Walking Trail. Henry Kendall Drive is a dirt road and is quite wide but be careful and aware of vehicular traffic.

Remember that this is a one way walk. If you don't feel up to the 4.4km return walk back to where you started from. You will need to make arrangements to have someone pick you up at the end. Port Macquarie Busways Route 332 and 334 follow Ocean Drive parallel to this walk ([www.busways.com.au/port-macquarie](http://www.busways.com.au/port-macquarie)).

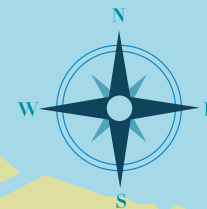
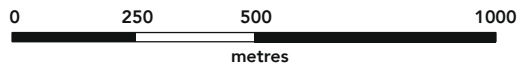
